#### **The image of China and India in British colonial literature**

#### **Central and Eastern Europe toward China and Taiwan during the Cold War**

The Cold War conflicts and divisions had influenced the global order and international relations for almost five decades. This lecture focuses on the impact of the Cold War politics on relations between the countries of the so-called Eastern Bloc and the "two Chinas". Apart from analyzing the broad framework of Eastern Bloc-China-Taiwan relations, dr. Antonina Luszczkiewicz from the Jagiellonian University in Kraków (Poland) will pay special attention to Polish-Chinese and Polish-Taiwanese relations by analyzing the case study of the detention of two Polish trade ships by Taiwanese authorities in the mid-1950s.
